



## The science behind the report:

# Better manage demanding workloads by upgrading to AI PCs powered by AMD Ryzen processors

This document describes what we tested, how we tested, and what we found. To learn how these facts translate into real-world benefits, read the report [Better manage demanding workloads by upgrading to AI PCs powered by AMD Ryzen processors](#).

We concluded our hands-on testing on February 21, 2026. During testing, we determined the appropriate hardware and software configurations and applied updates as they became available. The results in this report reflect configurations that we finalized on February 7, 2025 or earlier. Unavoidably, these configurations may not represent the latest versions available when this report appears.

# How we tested

## Initial system setup for all scenarios

### AMDTest folder

1. Download and extract the folder to the C drive.

### Installing AMD Adrenaline

1. Go to <https://www.amd.com/en/support/download/drivers.html> to get the latest AMD Adrenaline application.
2. Click Download Windows Drivers.
3. Open the executable, and proceed with installation.
4. Click Accept & Express Install to install the necessary drivers.
5. Wait for the installation to finish.
6. Restart the system when prompted.

## Collecting the latest news

### Installing Lemonade

1. Download Lemonade Server from <https://lemonade-server.ai/> and install it.
2. Proceed through the installation without changing any default options.
3. Make sure Run Lemonade Server now is checked before closing finishing the installation.
4. Wait for Lemonade to start. Lemonade notification will pop up once Lemonade is ready.
5. Right-click or left-click the Lemonade icon in your system tray popup, and set the Context Size to 32k.
6. Right-click or left-click the Lemonade icon in your system tray popup again, and select Open app.
7. In the Search models field, enter Qwen3-4b-Instruct-2507-FLM
8. Select the download button on the Qwen3-4b-Instruct-2507-FLM model.
9. Wait for the model download to finish.
10. Load the newly installed Qwen3-4B-Instruct-2507-FLM model by clicking Load.
11. Close the Lemonade app.

### Installing Generate

Note: Before proceeding, make sure Lemonade is running.

1. Launch the generateinstaller1216.exe file.
2. Click through the installation using the default selections.
3. After installation, launch Generate.
4. Enter your username, password and license key when the application loads the Register page.
5. From the upper-right Select Model drop-down menu, select Qwen3-4b-Instruct-2507-FLM.
6. After the model successfully loads, close Generate.

### AI-enhanced workflow

1. Launch Lemonade, and ensure that Qwen3-4b-Instruct-2507-FLM is loaded.
2. Launch Generate.
3. Simultaneously start the stopwatch and select the previously loaded Qwen3-4B-Instruct-2507-FLM model by clicking the Select an LLM drop-down menu.
4. Go through the installation popup screen using all of the default options, and click Finish.
5. When the model is fully loaded, from the left sidebar select the Agents option.
6. Select the Daily news brief workflow.
7. Modify options as follows:
8. Uncheck/unselect all topics.
9. In the Any specific preferences text box, type

I'm interested in AI developments made by AMD

10. For the Balance your feed section, slide the percentage to 50%.

11. Click Start reading.
12. Wait for the news brief to load.
13. Click the first news article that has loaded.
14. Click the article, and wait for the curating article content process to finish. Read along as the LLM generates the article.
15. Scroll to the top of the page, and click Generate AI Summary.
16. Wait for the summary to load.
17. Review the summary, and check that it matches the article content.
18. Open Word.
19. Copy the summary and paste it in Word.
20. Repeat steps 10 through 19 for the next four articles.
21. When you have copied five article summaries into Word, stop the stopwatch.
22. Record the time.
23. Repeat steps 1 through 22 two more times.

## Traditional workflow

1. Simultaneously start the stopwatch and open your browser.
2. In the search field, enter `recent AMD news`
3. Identify five relevant news articles from the search, and open them.
4. Open Word.
5. Skim through each article, and note down highlights in Word.
6. Review all the collected notes, and draft a summary in Word.
7. When the summary is complete, stop the stopwatch.
8. Record the time.
9. Repeat steps 1 through 8 two more times.

## Generating and scheduling tasks from emails

### Installing and setting up Lemonade

1. Download Lemonade Server from <https://lemonade-server.ai/>.
2. Launch the installation and use the default settings throughout the installation.
3. At the end of the installation, select the option to Run Lemonade Server now.
4. Wait 10 to 20 seconds for the Lemonade notification to pop up in the lower-right corner of the screen. Lemonade server is now running in the background.
5. If Lemonade isn't running, manually launch it through the Windows search bar.
6. In the taskbar, right-click the Lemonade icon, and select Open app.
7. In the search field in the left sidebar, type `Llama-3.2-3B-Instruct-Hybrid`
8. Select the download button next to the model.
9. When the download completes, load the newly installed model Llama-3.2-3B-Instruct-Hybrid by clicking on the play icon next to the model name.

### Installing and setting up Noodle

Note: For this test, we used an alpha version of the Noodle app that AMD provided to us.

1. Install the `noodle-ui2112025759p` executable.
2. Launch the Noodle executable.
3. Enter the purchased token in the Enrollment key field and select Enroll with Token.
4. Finish the installation with default settings.
5. In the app, select Settings.
6. In the Email Accounts section, click Connect on the Gmail/Google Workspace account.
7. Enter the username and password for the account under test, and click Save.
8. In the AI Configuration section of settings, under AI Mode, select AMD Lemonade from the drop-down menu.
9. In the AI Configuration section, under Model Name, enter `LFM2-8B-A1B-GGUF`
10. Select Save AI Configuration.

## AI-enhanced workflow

1. Open Noodle.
2. Simultaneously start the stop watch and open the Emails page in the application.
3. Find the Pippin Fiesta email, and select it.
4. Click Ask to ask questions and create tasks related to the email.
5. This opens a new chat with the email as an attachment for context.
6. Provide the following prompt to break the tasks mentioned in the email into subtasks:

```
Break the tasks mentioned in the email into subtasks.
```

7. Click Send.
8. Copy the AI generated answer by clicking Copy.
9. Open Word.
10. Simultaneously paste the AI-generated answer into Word, and stop the stopwatch.
11. Record the results and repeat steps 1 through 10 two more times.

## Traditional workflow

1. Open Outlook.
2. Simultaneously start the stopwatch and select the Focused tab.
3. Find the Pippin Fiesta email, and select it.
4. Open Word.
5. Read the email, and create a list of subtasks in Word.
6. When the list of subtasks is complete, stop the stopwatch.
7. Record the results and repeat steps 1 through 6 two more times.

## Summarizing a meeting transcript

### Setting up Lemonade

1. Download and install Lemonade Server from <https://lemonade-server.ai/>.
2. Place the LFM2-2.6B-Transcript-1-GGUF model file in a folder titled Liquid in the Downloads folder.
3. In Windows Search, type CMD
4. With the Command Prompt highlighted, select Run as administrator.
5. In the Command Prompt window, type

```
lemonade-server serve -extra-models-dir C:/Users/Username/Downloads/Liquid
```

6. Press Enter.
7. In the Taskbar, right-click the Lemonade icon, select Load Model and choose extra.LFM2-26B-Transcript-1-GGUF.gguf.

### Setting up Generate AI

Note: Before proceeding, make sure Lemonade is running.

1. Launch the generateinstaller1216.exe file.
2. Click through the installation using the default selections.
3. After installation, launch Generate.
4. After the application loads the Register page, enter your username, password, and license key.
5. Close Generate.

## AI-enhanced workflow

1. Launch the Lemonade-server application.
2. In the Taskbar, right-click the Lemonade icon, select Load Model, and choose extra.LFM2-26B-Transcript-1-GGUF.gguf.
3. Select the Generate AI/PC menu on the lower right, and select Settings.
4. Select the Card Manager tab.
5. Select New Card + on the lower-right side. It opens new screen to edit a card.
6. In Category, select General.
7. Select the icon field, and choose an icon from the window that appears.

8. In the tile field, enter

Meeting Minutes Creator

9. In the description field, enter

The card will ingest your meeting transcript or notes and then be able to generate full meeting minutes report.

10. In Step 1, choose Pick Integration for select a tool.

11. Select Add Another Tool, and select Pick File.

12. Select Step 1 for Select a step to pick integration.

13. Select Add Another Tool, select Get User Input.

14. In the Message field, type

Get input if not already written

15. In the Question field, type

What points did you want to focus on?

16. Select Add Another Tool, select Search Vector DB.

17. In the Message field, type

Select integration if not already written

18. In the Query field, type

Pull all relevant content from the meeting notes/transcript that include action items, next steps, meeting participants, have a focus on the areas covered here \$3.output.

19. Select Step 1 for Select a step to pick integration.

20. Select Step 2 for Select a step to pick source.

21. For No of Chunks, type 5

22. Select Add Another Tool, select Generate LLM Response.

23. In the Message field, type

Generating Response if not already written.

24. In the Instruction field, type

You are a meeting note taker, using the meeting transcript/notes create a full meeting minutes report that highlights the main points of the meeting, key takeaways, action items, along with any other relevant content that would need to be considered.  
When outputting the report, create it with this guideline covering these sections in order:  
Participants of the Meeting  
Executive Summary  
Key Points from the Meeting  
Action Items  
Don't have to necessarily include all the points mentioned earlier if there is not much data.  
Provide result in text format that does not contain tables or other heavy formatting, just basic formatting like using strictly dashes and spaces only. And include as little formatting as possible please. And please structure spaces accurately and consistently.  
Please provide output that when copied for usage, will provide all the formatting of the generated results.  
Make the final output as short and concise as possible.

25. In the Relevant content field, type

\$4.output

26. Click Save.

27. Simultaneously start the stopwatch and click the Select Model drop-down menu in the upper-right corner.
28. Select the user.LFM2-2.6B-Transcript-1-GGUF model to load it.
29. Go to Home, search for Meeting Minutes Creator, and open it.
30. Click Local Files option.
31. Click Upload file, navigate to your meeting notes Word file, and upload it.
32. Select the uploaded meeting note file, and click Continue.
33. Provide the main point you want to focus on from the meeting and continue.
34. Wait for it to generate the response.
35. Open Word.
36. Copy the generated meeting notes summary, and paste it into Word.
37. Simultaneously stop the stopwatch and save the Word document.
38. Record the time.
39. Repeat steps 1 through 38 two more times.

## Traditional workflow

1. Simultaneously start the timer and open the meeting transcript with Word.
2. Read through the entire document carefully, identifying:
  - Participants of the meeting
  - Executive summary
  - Key points from the meeting
  - Action items
3. Highlight or note down the important sections manually.
4. Open a new blank Word document to begin drafting the meeting minutes.
5. Start writing the report using the following structure:
  - **Participants of the meeting** (*List all attendees based on the transcript*)
  - **Executive summary** (*Summarize the overall purpose and outcome of the meeting*)
  - **Key points from the meeting** (*List major topics discussed and insights shared*)
  - **Action items** (*Mention tasks assigned, responsible persons, and deadlines if available*)
6. Use only basic formatting: dashes for bullet points and consistent spacing.
7. Review the document for clarity, conciseness, and completeness.
8. Simultaneously stop the stopwatch and save the Word document.
9. Record the time.
10. Repeat steps 1 through 9 two more times.

## Building a predetermined application (vibe coding) with AI assistance

Our AI-enhanced workflow used a local LLM hosted by Lemonade Server, which we accessed directly from Continue.dev in VS Code. This provided AI-assisted code generation and error checking without switching applications. We completed the workflow three times to determine the median completion time.

1. Launch Lemonade Server, and load Qwen3-Coder-30B-A3B-Instruct-GGUF (for its suitability for coding).
2. Open VS Code, and confirm Continue.dev is installed and you are signed in.
3. Configure Continue.dev to point to your local Lemonade endpoint (default: <http://localhost:8000/api/v1>).
4. Prompt the AI assistant in VS Code to create the initial web application.
5. Review the AI-generated code directly in the VS Code editor with the Problems panel for quick error detection.
6. Run and test the final application with Node.js, and curl to verify endpoints. (Windows 11 contains Curl by default. You can also download and install from <https://curl.se/windows/>.)

### Installing tools

#### Installing Lemonade Server

1. Open a browser.
2. Navigate to <https://lemonade-server.ai/>.
3. Download Windows 11.
4. Save Lemonade\_Server\_Installer.exe file locally.
5. Run Lemonade\_Server\_Installer.exe.
6. At the Welcome screen, click Next.
7. At the Choose Components screen, accept defaults, and click Next.
8. At the Select Installation Directory, accept defaults, and click Install.

#### Installing VS Code

1. Open a browser.
2. Navigate to <https://code.visualstudio.com/download>.
3. Click the Windows 10, 11 button.
4. Save VSCodeUserSetup-x64-1.104.3.exe locally.
5. Run VSCodeUserSetup-x64-1.104.3.exe.
6. At the License Agreement screen, select I accept the agreement, and click Next.
7. At the Select Additional Tasks screen, accept defaults, and click Next.
8. At the Ready to Install screen, click Install.

#### Installing Continue.dev

1. Open VS Code.
2. On the left sidebar, click Extensions.
3. Type Continue in the search bar, and on the Continue - open-source AI code agent extension, click Install.

#### Installing Node.js

1. Open a browser.
2. Navigate to <https://nodejs.org/en/download>.
3. Click the Windows Installer (.msi) button.
4. Save node-v22.20.0-x64.msi locally.
5. Run node-v22.20.0-x64.msi.
6. At the Welcome screen, click Next.
7. At the License Agreement screen, click I accept the terms in the license agreement, and click Next.
8. At the Destination Folder screen, accept defaults, and click Next.
9. At the Custom Setup screen, accept defaults, and click Next.
10. At the Tools for Native Modules screen, accept defaults, and click Next.
11. At the Ready to Install Node.js screen, click Install.

## Preparing to test

### Setting up Lemonade Server

1. Launch Lemonade Server.
2. Lemonade Server will run in the system tray. Right-click the lemon, and select Model Manager.
3. On the left sidebar, click Coding.
4. Download the Qwen3-Coder-30B-A3B-Instruct-GGUF model.
5. Allow the model to fully download.
6. Setting up Continue.dev
7. Open VS Code.
8. On the left side of VS Code, click Continue in the Activity Bar to open the Continue sidebar.
9. In the Continue sidebar, click the agent selector drop-down menu above the chat dialog box, hover over Local Agent, and click the gear to open your config file (config.yaml). This will add a Local Agent pointing to Lemonade.
10. Paste this minimal model block into config.yaml:

11. Save the file. Click Reload config in the Continue sidebar. Select Qwen3 Coder 30B (Lemonade) from the agent drop-down menu.
12. To perform a quick smoke test, in the Continue chat box, type a reply with the word `READY` only. You should receive the response `READY`.

### Preparing the local LLM server

1. Launch Lemonade Server. Lemonade Server will run in the system tray.
2. Right-click the lemon, and select Model Manager.
3. Prepare the stopwatch.
4. Simultaneously start the stopwatch and, from the drop-down menu, select Qwen3-Coder-30B-A3B-Instruct-GGUF. When the model has loaded, the model name will turn green in the upper-right corner of the web UI.

### Configuring Continue.dev in VS Code

1. Open VS Code.
2. To open the Continue sidebar, click the Continue icon in the Activity Bar on the left side of VS Code.
3. On the Continue sidebar, click the + to start a new session.
4. Ensure Qwen3 Code 30B (Lemonade) is selected in the model drop-down menu.

### Creating the initial web application (HTTP server)

1. In the Continue.dev chat panel in VS Code, enter the following prompt:

```
Create an HTTP server with Javascript on port 3000 with these exact routes:
- GET /api/users - return users array
- POST /api/users - create user from JSON body
Use in-memory storage with default user 'mexicat', include CORS, JSON parsing, and basic error
handling. Single file only.
```

2. Wait for the model to finish generating its response. Copy the created js contents into a new file in VS Code.
3. With the new file tab open, go to File → Save As..., choose the folder in which you're working, and name the file `http_server.js`. Click Save.

## Verifying code is error-free

Check the Problems panel at the bottom of VS Code (Ctrl+Shift+M) and verify that there are no issues.

## Testing the application

1. Open the Terminal panel at the bottom of VS Code.
2. Navigate to the folder containing the `http_server.js` file.
3. To start the server, run `node http_server.js`.
4. Verify that the console outputs Server running on port 3000.
5. Open a new Terminal tab (Ctrl+Shift+') to keep the server running.
6. To test the GET endpoint, run `curl.exe http://localhost:3000/api/users`. The HTTP server should respond with information about the created user. Responses won't always be the same given the vagueness of the creation prompt.
7. Upon verification of the endpoint, stop the stopwatch and record the time.

## Submitting a new Jira ticket

### Setting up Lemonade

1. Download and install Lemonade Server from <https://lemonade-server.ai/>
2. Proceed through the installation without changing any default options.
3. Make sure Run Lemonade Server now is checked before closing finishing the installation.
4. Right-click or left-click the Lemonade icon in your system tray popup again and select Open app.
5. In the Search models field, enter

```
gpt-oss-20b-mx4p4-GGUF
```

6. Select the download button on the gpt-oss-20b-mx4p4-GGUF model.
7. Click the llama.cpp category under the BY RECIPE panel. Scroll down to find gpt-oss-20b-mx4p4-GGUF and download it.
8. Load the newly installed gpt-oss-20b-mx4p4-GGUF model by clicking the Load icon next to the model name.
9. Close the Lemonade app.

### Setting up Generate AI PC

1. Launch the `generateinstaller1216.exe` file.
2. Click through the installation using the default selections.
3. After installation, launch Generate.
4. After the application loads the Register page, enter your username, password, and license key.
5. Click the Select Model drop-down menu in the upper-right corner, select gpt-oss-20b-mx4p4-GGUF.
6. After the model successfully loads, close Generate.

### Setting up JIRA

1. Go to <https://www.atlassian.com/software/jira> and sign up or log in using your account.
2. Select Continue without two-factor authentication.
3. Select Jira Service Management. It opens a new tab.
4. Make a note of the URL before `/Jira/projects`. For example: `https://amdradteam1.atlassian.net`.
5. Return to the previous tab.
6. Click the profile picture on the upper-right side of the screen, and select Account settings.
7. Select Security on the upper section of the screen.
8. Click Create and manage API tokens, and verify your identity.
9. Click Create API token, provide name and expiry date, and click Create.
10. Copy the generated API token and save it securely.
11. Click Done and close the tab.

## AI-enhanced workflow

1. Run Lemonade-server application.
2. Open Generate AIPC application, click MCP Playground and select the setting icon beside the JIRA option and fill in below details and click Save.
