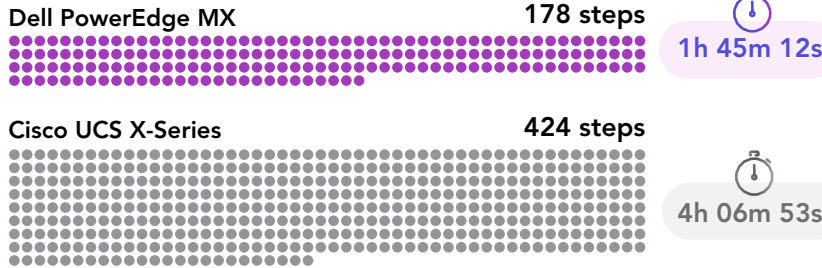

Total time and steps to complete migration

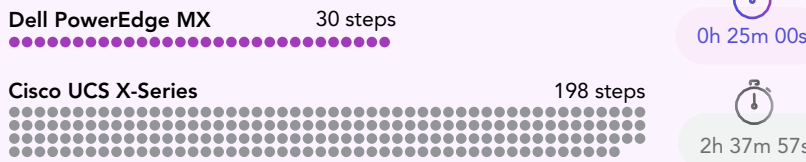

The charts below present the three phases of the migration process.



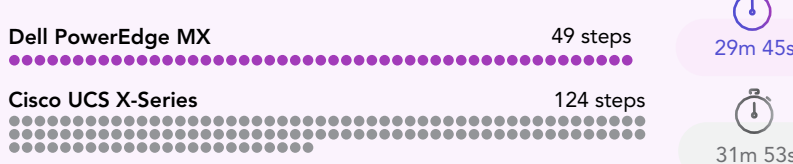
Phase 1: Initial configuration tasks

to complete initial configuration



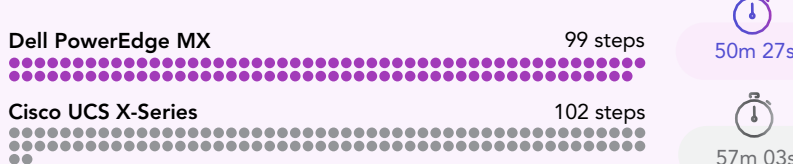
Phase 2: Server profile configuration and deployment tasks
