

# The new HP Elite Dragonfly G3 outperformed a previous-generation device across a series of tests

To help shed light on the benefits of upgrading older devices, we conducted hands-on testing of two similarly configured HP Elite Dragonfly laptops:

- The latest-generation Dragonfly G3 featuring a 12<sup>th</sup> Gen Intel® Core™ i7-1265U processor
- A previous-generation Dragonfly G2 featuring an 11<sup>th</sup> Gen Intel Core i7-1185G7 processor

The Dragonfly G3 featuring a 12<sup>th</sup> Gen Intel Core i7-1265U processor outperformed the previous-generation device in all of our tests.

SYSmark 25 overall rating | Higher is better




Figure 1: SYSmark 25 benchmark test results. We ran the test three times and report the median result. Higher is better. Source: Principled Technologies.

CrossMark overall rating | Higher is better




Figure 2: CrossMark benchmark test results. We ran the test three times and report the median result. Higher is better. Source: Principled Technologies.

WebXPRT 4 on Edge overall score | Higher is better




Figure 3: WebXPRT 4 benchmark test results. We ran the test three times and report the median result. Higher is better. Source: Principled Technologies.
